



4:14-15 The Summary

HIS AUTHORITY

who He is

**Jesus' Authority
was clearly Seen**

4:16-30 The Conversation

Jesus identified Himself as the Messiah who is...

- The Anointed and Sent One from God
- The Fulfilment of the OT prophesy

4:31-44 The Miracles

Jesus' Authority is seen through...

- His Teaching and Power over spirits & sickness
- His Recognition by the spirits

HIS MINISTRY

what He did

**Jesus' Ministry
was clearly
the Gospel**

The Messiah to proclaim the good news to all...

- Even to the "Marginalised"
- Even to the Gentiles

Jesus' teachings and healings
was meant to point to
the Heart of His ministry

PP's RESPONSES

how pp respond to Him

**People's Responses
were clearly Mixed**

Some **spoke well** of Him,

Some **marvelled**

Some were **sceptical**

Some **offended and angry**

(to the point of wanting to kill Him)
due to Jesus' remark about them

Many were **astonished & amazed**

News spread to regions

People **held Him from leaving**

Reflection on Authority

**How is my basis of doing the gospel work
driven by Christ-given authority?**

In reality, we tend to be rely on...

(Experience, Knowledge, my own Limitations)

How to make sense of this?

Reflection on Receiving Different Responses

*Expecting different responses is a good first step;
Expected to respond back is the next essential step.*

Recall a past gospel conversation.

**How can you engage the person more meaningfully
and not to dismiss it?**

Reflection on my response to Him

**What is my response to Jesus in my life?
Am I responding to Him seriously?**
