

Luke 9:18-50 (The glorious king is worth living and dying for)

1. The identity of Jesus

- Jesus wants Peter to get His identity right and the author wants us to know that
- He is the Christ, the chosen King (v20, v35)
who must suffer, be rejected, and to die, (v22)
on the third day be raised to life (v22)

2. The cost of following Jesus

- To deny self: To renounce anything that challenges our allegiance to the King
- To take up your cross daily: Ready to bear sufferings in our allegiance to the King

3. The worth of following Jesus

- The disciples may lose hope
- Though He would suffer and die, Jesus revealed He is still the King of Glory (v29)
- The King is worth living, dying and losing everything for,
- because His death will accomplished the mission to fulfill salvation (v31)

4. The attitude of following Jesus

- Jesus's followers are to be Christ-like humble and inclusive (v46-50)
- Just as the king humbled himself to the cross
