| <i><u>Question:</u> How would Caleb’s example change your attitude towards receiving or work with people whom you deem as difficult or whom you do not prefer or even dislike?</i> | |
| c. ...to difficult task/assignment (V10-15) | Deut 1:36, Joshua 14:12 (NLT); Joshua 15:13-14 |
| <i><u>Question:</u> Caleb’s vigour and boldness stamped from his faith in God. How could that impact the way you respond to tasks that are difficult or tasks that are not of your preference?</i> | |
