

Conduct in the face of difficulty

Acts 22:30-23:11

Introduction

1) Paul, as a Jew and Pharisee, has been dutiful and zealous for the law, keeping a clear conscience (v1-5)

Implication

We must be able to pick up inconsistencies in the approaches to ministry and be quick to humbly admit our shortcomings when highlighted by others

2) Paul, as a Pharisee, had to come to terms with Jesus' resurrection, which also became a point of contention (v6-10)

Implication

We must stand in our conviction of the gospel work in our ministry when faced with opposition.

3) The Lord encouraged Paul regarding his destination. (v11)

Implication

We must be encouraged and ready to do God's will when presented the assurance of His direction.
