

## **Conduct in the face of difficulty**

Acts 22:30-23:11

Introduction

**1) Paul, as a Jew and Pharisee, has been dutiful and zealous for the law, keeping a clear conscience (v1-5)**

### **Implication**

We must be able to pick up inconsistencies in the approaches to ministry and be quick to humbly admit our shortcomings when highlighted by others

**2) Paul, as a Pharisee, had to come to terms with Jesus' resurrection, which also became a point of contention (v6-10)**

### **Implication**

We must stand in our conviction of the gospel work in our ministry when faced with opposition.

**3) The Lord encouraged Paul regarding his destination. (v11)**

### **Implication**

We must be encouraged and ready to do God's will when presented the assurance of His direction.
