- Paul refused to go to Jerusalem to be judged but appealed to be judged at Caesar's court in Rome (Acts 25:6-12)
- King Agrippa arrived at Caesarea and Festus told him about Paul's case (Acts 25:13-22)
- Paul's defense before King Agrippa (Acts 25:23-26:29)
- Acknowledgement by King Agrippa of Paul's innocence (Acts 26:30-32)

1. Relentless opposition; vindication without due justice

2. Clear conviction of calling; resolute obedience to calling

3. Providential assurance; providential fulfilment
