

## Numbers 32: Be Faithful, for He who leads you is Faithful!

**Main Idea:** By recording Israel's journey, the new generation of Israelites **must remember** God's **faithfulness** and they are to **remain faithful to Him** when they enter Canaan.

Section	Key Lessons	How does it fit into the main idea of Num 33?
<b>A. A Record of Israel's Journey (v1-49)</b>	Like the Israelites, we are to <b>remember</b> what God has done in our lives & save us.  Ps 105:5	<b>The younger generation of Israel must look back &amp; remember God's faithfulness.</b>
<b>B. God commands the expulsion of the Canaanites (v50-56)</b>	Just as the Israelites were instructed to drive out the inhabitants of Canaan, we too are to <b>get rid of any sins in our lives, not being friends with the world &amp; be wary of idols.</b>  <u><b>Get rid of sins in our lives:</b></u> Colossians 3:5, Hebrews 12:1  <u><b>Not being friends with the world &amp; be wary of idols:</b></u> 1 John 2:15,16; 5:21, James 4:4	<b>The younger generation must also look forward &amp; take heed of God's word.</b>

### How can we remain Faithful to Him & His cause?

1. We can seek God's guidance in our decisions and circumstances, and trust in God's provision and care in times of need.
2. We must not be friends with the world, and be wary of idols in our lives.
3. We must remember God's faithfulness and guidance in our lives, even in challenging times.
