

Numbers 35 - Living as God's People in the Promised Land

As God prepares the Israelites to live as His people in the Promised Land, He wants:

1. Godly influence to spread throughout the land (Num 35:1-1-8)

[God commands the Israelites to give cities and pasturelands to the Levites from their inheritance]

- Over whom do we exert godly influence?

2. Purity to be maintained in the land (Num 35:9-34)

[God commands the Israelites to set up 6 cities of refuge]

Implication 1: City of refuge as a picture of salvation in Christ

Implication 2: Christian communities as cities of refuge
