



¹ And getting into a boat He crossed over and came to His own city.

² And behold, some people brought to Him a paralytic, lying on a bed. And when Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic,
"Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven."

³ And behold, some of the scribes said to themselves,
"This man is blaspheming."

⁴ But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said,
"Why do you think evil in your hearts?

⁵ ***For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise and walk'?***

⁶ ***But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins***"

--He then said to the paralytic--- ***"Rise, pick up your bed and go home."***

⁷ And he rose and went home.

⁸ When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to men.

¹⁸ While He was saying these things to them,

behold, a ruler came in and knelt before Him, saying,

"My daughter has just died, but come and lay Your hand on her, and she will live."

¹⁹ And Jesus rose and followed him, with His disciples.

²⁰ And behold, a woman who had suffered from a discharge of blood

for twelve years came up behind Him and touched the fringe of His garment,

²¹ for she said to herself,

"If I only touch His garment, I will be made well."

²² Jesus turned, and seeing her He said,

"Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well."

And instantly the woman was made well.

²³ And when Jesus came to the ruler's house

and saw the flute players and the crowd making a commotion,

²⁴ He said, **"Go away, for the girl is not dead but sleeping."** And they laughed at Him.

²⁵ But when the crowd had been put outside,

He went in and took her by the hand, and the girl arose.

²⁶ And the report of this went through all that district.



²⁷ And as Jesus passed on from there,
two blind men followed Him, crying aloud,
"Have mercy on us, Son of David."

²⁸ When He entered the house, the blind men came to Him, and Jesus said to them,
"Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to Him, **"Yes, Lord."**

²⁹ Then He touched their eyes, saying, **"According to your faith be it done to you."**

³⁰ And their eyes were opened.
And Jesus sternly warned them, **"See that no one knows about it."**

³¹ But they went away and spread His fame through all that district.

³² As they were going away,
behold, a demon-oppressed man who was mute was brought to Him.

³³ And when the demon had been cast out, the mute man spoke.
And the crowds marveled, saying, **"Never was anything like this seen in Israel."**
³⁴ But the Pharisees said, **"He casts out demons by the prince of demons."**


