

# Christ Is Enough - Don't move on from Him, Grow deep in Him (Col 2:6-15)

## Introduction

**BI:** Because we are united to Christ, who is fully God and fully sufficient, we already have everything we need. So, we grow not by moving beyond Him, but by going deeper in Him.

### 1. Continue in Christ, Don't Move Beyond Him (Col 2:6-7)

**Principle 1: Christian growth happens by deepening our relationship with Christ, not by moving beyond Him.**

### 2. Guard Your Mind, Don't Be Taken Captive (Col 2:8)

**Principle 2: Anything that shifts our dependence away from Christ is spiritually dangerous.**

### 3. Rest in Christ, You Are Already Full (Col 2:9-10)

**Principle 3: Because Christ is fully God, and we are in Him, we lack nothing spiritually.**

### 4. Know Who You Are, Your Identity Is in Christ (Col 2:11-12)

**Principle 4: Our identity and belonging come from union with Christ, not external practices.**

### 5. Live It Out, You Are Alive, Forgiven, and Victorious (Col 2:13-15)

**Principle 5: Because of the cross, our sins are forgiven, our debt is cancelled, and no power has authority over us anymore.**
